TRAVEL TRAILER CHECKLIST

INTERIOR OF TRAILER

- Water Pump off
- Water Heater off
- Furnace off, portable heaters stowed
- TV & electronics secured
- TV antenna & satellite dish down
- Loose items from countertops, cabinets, & bathroom stowed or secured
- Furniture secured
- Cabinet drawers & doors closed & secured
- Refrigerator switched off or to propane
- Refrigerator items secured and door latched
- Stove top secured
- Toilet seat down
- All doors shut & secured
- Windows & vents closed
- Interior lights off

EXTERIOR OF TRAILER

- Tailgate down for hitching 5th wheel
- Proper hitch connection, safety chains breakaway cable, locking pin
- Perform tug test
- Electrical pigtail securely connected
- Stabilizer properly connected
- External lights working and clean (turn, brake, clearance)
- Tires (air pressure, sidewall weather cracking, tread, valve stem extension)
- Lug Nut torque
- Axle Lubrication - bearing buddy
- Jacks, stabilizers retracted, stow pads
- Retract awnings & slides, clean debris
- Lock all Compartments

- Check propane and secure
- Remove wheel chocks
- Lock door and check for keys

TOW VEHICLE

- Engine fluids (Fuel, Oil, Brake fluid, Coolants, Transmission fluid)
- Engine compartment (Leaks, hoses, belts)
- Check for leaves, nest, debris lodged in the compartment
- Batteries
- Check brake control setting
- Windshield Cracks or chips
- Windshield wipers
- Mirrors adjusted & tight
- Tires (air pressure, sidewall weather cracking, tread)
- Lights (brake, turn, clearance markers etc.)
- Transmission set to tow mode

CHECK WHEN LEAVING THE CAMPSITE

- Put loose items away (chairs, grills, rugs)
- Dump tanks
- Check fresh water level
- Stow away the sewer hose, water hose, power chord and all attachments
- Turn off all pilot lights
- Properly dump all trash
- Check exit route for any obstructions

PERSONAL INFO TO KEEP ON BOARD

- Driver license, Proof of insurance
- Emergency contact information
- Medical Information
- Trip routing and plan
